## First Stop: "Bet Shabtai Levi"

An emergency shelter for children in early childhood

Established in December 1995, treated 319 children aged 0-6, mostly of the north district. In the last four years the number of children taken into the center has decreased gradually, out of the Welfare ministry's concept to work for taking care of the early age children with closeness to their family in their community, as much as possible. These days, there are 34 kids who enjoyed your gifts **as you can see:**

## Second Stop: “Yamin Orde” youth village

### A youth village hardly damaged by the fire

founded in 1953 in order to accommodate Holocaust orphans and immigrant children during the great immigration waves of the fifties. Today, the 77-acre campus is home to more than 500 children from around the world. The campus includes a high school offering a complete academic curriculum.

**The terrible fire** that swept through the village in Dec. 2010, nearly destroyed the youth village: 40% of the buildings were severely damaged or burned to the ground. Yemin Orde kids & youth, as well as the staff’s children who lost their houses- enjoyed your gifts

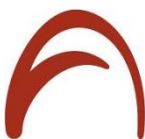


## Third Stop: “Yad B’Yad” warm homes

### After School facilities for at-risk young children

The Association runs 10 such houses in the center of the country, where children at risk between the ages of three and a half and seven come after kindergarten and school hours. The children stay until six in the evening and receive from the professional staff everything that their families and neighborhood can't provide: Hot meals, cognitive enrichment, emotional support, appreciation of values and normative behavior, and a lot of warmth and love.
